DEMONSTRATION - NOT A CLIENT AUDIT

This sample demonstrates how a small, prioritized Website Check report makes observed defects reproducible. The fixture contains three deliberate issues and working comparison controls. No real client site or form was tested.

Fieldwork synthetic service website. Captured 2026-09-13 23:47:54.232 UTC.

Three fictional pages and one intentionally missing destination. Findings describe controlled fixture behavior, not customer work or measured business results.

Exactly what was reviewed.

Local synthetic fixture. Three pages and one intentionally missing destination; no production client site.

Captured means a browser view was recorded. It does not mean the page passed QA. Blocked views were not verified and must not be reported as passing.

Paths refer to the temporary local loopback fixture used for this demonstration. /request/ deliberately returns HTTP 404.

Interpretation

Findings on the following pages require reproduced user impact. A captured 404 is evidence of the response; it is assessed against the intended journey. An unavailable view remains a limitation.

Primary enquiry link ends at a 404.

High priority

desktop-chromium //request/

A visitor following the main consultation action cannot reach its intended destination.

SYNTHETIC QA FIXTURE - DELIBERATELY FLAWED

404 / Page unavailable.

The consultation destination does not exist in this synthetic fixture.

Evidence broken-cta-desktop-chromium / Chromium 147.0.7727.15 / viewport 1440 x 900

Reproduce

- 1. Open the Home page in desktop Chromium.
- 2. Activate Request a consultation.
- 3. Observe the destination response and page heading.

Expected

The primary action opens a usable consultation or contact destination.

Observed

The browser navigates to /request/. The server returns HTTP 404 and the page displays Page unavailable.

Suggested next action

Point the primary action to the intended working enquiry page, then repeat the journey from Home.

Reproduced in 2 fresh contexts. Verified 2026-09-13 23:48:00.159 UTC. The screenshot records the visible state; reproduction checks support the interaction finding.

Mobile notice covers the enquiry action.

High priority

mobile-webkit / /contact/

At the tested mobile viewport, a visitor cannot tap the enquiry action because another element receives the pointer.



Reproduce

1. Open /contact/ using mobile WebKit at 390 x 844.
2. Locate the Send enquiry action beneath the two fields.
3. Attempt a normal pointer interaction with the action.

Expected

The action remains visible, unobstructed and available to a pointer user.

Observed

The availability panel overlaps the button. A hit test identifies the overlay, and Playwright actionability checks reject the click.

Suggested next action

Place the availability note in normal layout flow and verify the button can be tapped at the affected width.

Reproduced in 2 fresh contexts. Verified 2026-09-13 23:48:00.159 UTC. The screenshot records the visible state; reproduction checks support the interaction finding.

Options control is skipped by the keyboard.

Medium priority

desktop-chromium //details/

A keyboard user cannot reach or activate Show options through the ordinary Tab sequence.

Consultation options

Show options

Options are hidden.

Evidence bad-keyboard-desktop-chromium / Chromium 147.0.7727.15 / viewport 1440 x 900

Reproduce

- 1. Open /details/ in desktop Chromium.
- 2. Use Tab to traverse the navigation and page controls.
- 3. Observe that Show options is skipped while Show details receives focus.

Expected

A control that responds to a pointer also supports keyboard focus and activation.

Observed

Show options is a non-focusable div with no role. Pointer activation works; keyboard traversal skips it and the options remain hidden.

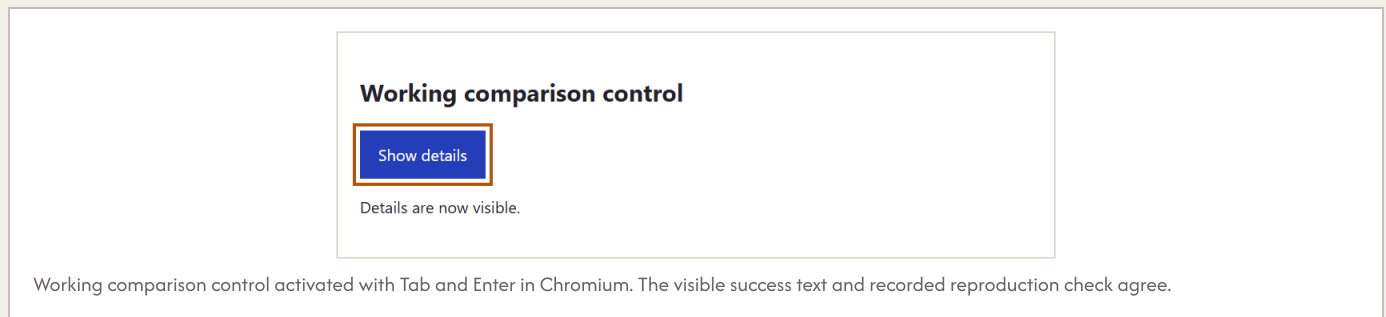
Suggested next action

Use a native button with the existing behavior, then verify Tab focus and Enter/Space activation.

Reproduced in 2 fresh contexts. Verified 2026-09-13 23:48:00.159 UTC. The screenshot records the visible state; reproduction checks support the interaction finding.

What was checked.

Check	Status	Observed boundary
Working navigation	passed	Home to Details and 404 return link worked in both browser profiles, twice.
Keyboard comparison	passed	The native Show details button received Tab focus and responded to Enter in both profiles.
Desktop demo action	passed	The local Send enquiry button was unobstructed at 1440 x 900; its local message changed. It sends nothing.
Real message delivery	not-tested	No real form, API submission, inbox or CRM was used.
Physical devices	not-tested	Browser emulation only; no iOS or Android hardware was used.



Interpretation and limits

- Observed behavior is limited to the four explicit URLs and two recorded browser profiles.
- Mobile WebKit runs on this workstation with a 390 x 844 viewport and touch emulation. It is not a physical-device Safari test.
- This is a synthetic demonstration, not customer proof, an accessibility certification, a security audit or a business-outcome claim.
- Suggestions identify the next action; implementation and repair verification are separate work.

Handoff

Prioritize the confirmed issues, agree any repairs separately, then verify the affected behavior after changes. This report does not include implementation or ongoing support.
